What is the Endeavor Program?

The Endeavor Program seeks to provide scouts with advance knowledge in several widely varying topics in the natural sciences. Camp Barton is uniquely situated within a half hour drive of some of the most sophisticated research institutions and greatest natural examples in a myriad of fields. Scouts will be exposed to complex topics far beyond what is normally provided in either the camp or high school settings. Scouts will have four days off camp property visiting institutes like the Museum of the Earth, Cornell's Laboratory for Accelerator-based Sciences and Education (particle accelerator), Cayuga Nature Center's High Ropes Course, and Treman State Park, and one day on camp property.
