Scouting America, acting through the National Court of Honor, may award the Silver Antelope for distinguished service to youth upon the following basis and procedure:

- 1. The official nomination form for the current year must be used.
- 2. Give the nominee's full name and title; avoid the use of nicknames.
- 3. Provide as much information as necessary using the space provided on this form. No additional documents should be attached other than supporting letters of recommendation. **Incomplete nominations will not be considered.** Supporting letters are accepted electronically and should provide supporting evidence of worthiness to earn the award, not just include personal recommendations or endorsements.
- 4. Nominations cannot be considered for posthumous awards.
- 5. Nomination forms with no more than 2 recommendation letters must be submitted together electronically with this form to the National Council <u>no</u> later than December 15th for recognition the following year.
- 6. Applications will be evaluated by the appropriate CST and ranked for submission to the National Court of Honor.
- 7. The National Court of Honor will consider the CST recommendations and make the final selections.
- 8. The Silver Antelopes will be awarded at the National Annual Meeting.
