Because offerings differ from year to year, there are no distinct codes for individual Philmont Training Center, Sea Base, or Summit Bechtel Reserve conferences. A single code for any national commissioner training conference attended at one of those locations is now available. Distinct codes are available for each College of Commissioner Science degree plus Commissioner College Continuing Education course attendance. A code for “Advanced Commissioner Training” is available to recognize the variety of other commissioner training opportunities available through local workshops, conferences, etc.

Who is considered a Trained Commissioner?

A trained Commissioner has completed Position-Specific Training. A new commissioner will be presented with a commission after completion. Completion also triggers the display of the “Trained” emblem in my scouting tools.

Once Commissioned, are we done with training?

Actually, we have only begun! We know our training never ends in our role as commissioners. We must continually adjust our skills to provide valuable service to our units. Commissioners should view continuous learning as essential to their success.
